Hello, January has not got off to the best start, what with the snow and rain. I don't think we are out of the woods yet, as far as the snow is concerned, but I hope to be proved wrong.

Our plans for the course for the next quarter are to rebuild the two bunkers on the 15th green, using a method known as revetting, this is a process using old turf to build the face of the bunker. If this works well we will use this method on other bunkers later on.

Some of you might be wondering what the frames in front of the new shed are, these are the frames for the new winter tees which we will be putting out soon, once in place we will be putting hard standing areas next to them, with a path leading to and from each mat.

We are also looking into a major drainage operation but this will not happen over night.

We also want to build up the 6th, 10th, 11th and 14th tees similar to the 2nd tee, which will be re-drained so drying it out.

Of course this is all subject to the weather and conditions.

Lastly we hope to be moving into the new shed very soon which is quite exciting. It will be sad to leave the old barn after all these years but the new shed is much better situated and better equipped.

We were delighted when Ampfield Golf Club won its first ever pro-am tournament at the Oxfordshire Golf Club. The team was lead by Ampfields head professional Jon Barnes along with two of Ampfields Directors Paul and John Hazell and a member of Ampfield Golf Club, Andrew Toomer. The team managed a total of (-19) to win by one shot and claim the title along with some excellent prizes, which included full Galvin Green suits for each amateur. Our head professional Jon Barnes finished fourth with a score of (-4), which included an eagle at the par 4, 14th hole!

Ampfield also took part in the Cornish Festival, with the same team as above and played three pro-am rounds at Perranporth, Newquay and St Enedoc Golf Clubs, finishing in the top 15 out of over 60 teams. We were happy with the result but the team felt as though they could have contended for the title had it not been for the terrible weather conditions they endured whilst playing at the windy seaside links of Perranporth. However, the team is very much looking forward to trying again in April, this year.

SUCCESS FOR HEAD PROFESSIONAL, JON BARNES

Jon's first win of the 2009 season saw him make a new course record at Hockley Golf Club, shooting a 65. Jon then went on to win a pro-am at the Shanklin & Sandown Golf Club and then a further three wins.
